This historical gem houses exquisite churches and towers dating back to the 16th and 17th centuries, offering mesmerizing views of the Jhinvali reservoir.

As we traverse the scenic route, we'll witness a unique natural wonder - the conjunction of two small mountain rivers, each retaining its distinct color even after merging. This captivating sight is a testament to the region's enchanting landscapes.

Onward we drive, giving you the opportunity to taste the pure and refreshing mineral mountain springs in Mleta, replenishing your spirits for the next part of the journey. Our route takes us over the majestic Cross Pass to Gudauri Ski Resort, where winter sports enthusiasts can revel in the snowy slopes, and those seeking a thrilling experience can take to the skies in Paragliding, guided by local professionals.

As we ascend further, the Cross Pass unveils a breathtaking panorama from the Soviet-era "People's Friendship" mountain viewpoint, offering vistas of the profound gorge in the Caucasus mountain range. En route to the charming town of Stepantsminda (Kazbegi), we'll pass by the striking Travertine formations in Kazbegi National Park, adding to the natural wonders of the day.

Arriving in Kazbegi, we'll switch to a sturdy four-wheel drive vehicle to reach the Gergeti Holy Trinity Church, perched at an altitude of 2170 meters. Revel in the awe-inspiring views of the majestic Mt. Kazbegi, creating a moment of serenity and grandeur.

Finally, our memorable expedition culminates as we head back to your hotel. We hope this extraordinary journey leaves you with unforgettable memories of Georgia's captivating landscapes, rich history, and warm hospitality.
