##### **DAY- 1 ARRIVAL IN TASHKENT - GUARANTEED EARLY CHECK IN - TASHKENT CITY TOUR**

- Arrival at Tashkent international airport and meet & greet our representative.
- You'll be transferred to the hotel. Proceed for early check in and relax.
- Later, proceed for the Tashkent city tour.
- We started our excursion through an old part of the city.
- We visit complex Khasi Imam, consisting of Kaffal Shashi Mausoleum (XV), Barak Khan Madrassah (XVI), Muay-Mubarak Mosque - storehouse of the well-known Koran of Khalif Osman and gold hair of prophet Muhammad.
- Dhumra-mosque of Khodja Akhtar Vali, Abdelkarim Madrassah (XIX).
- We visited Chorus national oriental bazaar for shopping.
- Return to the hotel. Overnight in Tashkent.



## DAY- 2 TASHKENT EXCURSION - TRANSFER TO SAMARKAND - CHECK IN

- Have a delicious breakfast at the hotel.
- After breakfast, get ready for an excursion of Tashkent.
- We start excursion through a new part of the city, Alisher Navoi Opera and Ballet Theatre, Amir Timur Square with a monument to the great commander in the center.
- We visit the famous Tashkent clocks and the Uzbekistan (In tourist) Hotel, Palace of Forums, "Broadway" – an alley of artists with inexpensive equipment, Monument of Courage, Tashkent TV Tower (from outside), Minor Mosque (White Mosque).
- In the evening, transfer to the station to take a high-speed train to Tashkent.
- Upon arrival, check in to the hotel. Overnight in Samarkand.

## DAY- 3 SAMARKAND CITY TOUR

- Enjoy a hearty breakfast at your hotel.
- After breakfast, we embarked for a city tour of Samarkand.
- We start the day by visiting the Mausoleum of Guri Emir – the tomb of Tamerlane – the place where Amir Temur, his sons and grandsons are buried.
- Registan Square is one of the outstanding examples of urban planning art of Central Asia.

Bibi Khanum Mosque is the largest in Central Asia and one of the largest in the entire Muslim world.

- But the main mausoleum, from where the necropolis begins, is the imaginary grave of the cousin of the Prophet Muhammad – Kusam Ibn Abbas.

Return back to the hotel. Overnight in Samarkand.

- Overnight in Tashkent.

### **VISA ON ARRIVAL:**

- Passport must be valid for more than 6 months and UAE residence visa must be valid. **Visas on arrival are subject to immigration approval sometimes.** Passengers must be residents of the UAE for the last 6 months.

### Cancellation Policy:

- Prior to 45 days or more: 30% of the holiday amount is non-refundable + Full cancellation for non-refundable tickets.
- 44 and 31 days of departure: 45% of the holiday cost
- 30 and 15 days of departure: 60% of the holiday cost
- 14 and 10 days of departure: 75% of the holiday cost.
- 10 days prior to departure 100% of the total amount will be deducted.
